I also saw them having their meals on time. The beneficiaries are accommodated in different buildings within the campus and are identified by their registration number. It took us time to find Munni since there were so many dorms and buildings and so many beneficiaries in the campus. When I finally met her, she confirmed receiving good care at Apna Ghar and timely meals on a regular basis.

The home at Bharatpur is their largest home and also their head office. I was there for the whole day and saw the beneficiaries being looked after very well by their caretakers. The beds are fabricated on campus, and the mattresses are made by buying sponge and covering it with rexine. They use rexine since it's easier to clean for bed ridden patients. The caretakers clean the beds everyday/multiple times a day depending on the beneficiary's condition/bowel habits.

I saw lunch being served at one of the homes- everyone sits down with their plates while one of the caretakers serves them. In case of women who are mentally unstable and unable to eat by themselves, the caretakers feed them separately. I met Haseena just after she had lunch.
