Each month, the birthdays of all the children born in that month are celebrated together along with cake and snacks.

Each month, the birthdays of all the children born in that month are celebrated together along with cake and snacks.

Each month, the birthdays of all the children born in that month are celebrated together along with cake and snacks.

He confirmed receiving the following items from Sarthak Prayas every month for the last couple of years: 4 varieties of dal, 1 kg sugar, 0.25 kgs tea powder, 1 ltr refined oil, 5 kgs atta, 2 kgs rice, biscuits, haldi, mirchi, jeera, and all kinds of masalas along with toiletries like 1 detergent soap, 1 body soap, and a toothpaste. They also get woollen clothing during winters.

They confirmed receiving the following items from Sarthak Prayas every month for the last couple of years: 4 varieties of dal, 1 kg sugar, 0.25 kgs tea powder, 1 ltr refined oil, 5 kgs atta, 2 kgs rice, biscuits, haldi, mirchi, jeera, and all kinds of masalas along with toiletries like 1 detergent soap, 1 body soap, and a toothpaste. They also get woollen clothing during winters.
