GiveIndia conducts surprise visits to the places where the NGOs are located. These visits are conducted to verify the information shared by the NGO about the benefits provided to the end beneficiaries. Our NGO Relationship Managers and a team of dedicated volunteers find the address of the beneficiary and visit them personally to confirm the validity of the NGO's work. Additional remarks by the Relationship Manager on beneficiary[1]	Prema Vabslal runs a Solar-lantern charging station at Shauklan Purwa village. She was provided with 50 lanterns in April 2015 by Shramik Bharti through Jagriti Mahila Samiti. She rents out each solar lamps to villagers at a Rs.100 per month. Out of her earnings she pays half the amount to the SHG towards maintenance. The payment to Jagriti Mahila Samiti is made mainly in cash every month for which a receipt is proveded as an acknowledgement of the payment (Verified the payment receipts of last 8 months).

Verification Visit status of beneficiary[2]	Success
Additional remarks by the Relationship Manager on beneficiary[2]	Neelu is the president of 'Maa Laxmi Mahila Swayam Sahayta Samooh'. She is managing the 'Maa Laxmi Grain Bank' inher home at Sabharpur, Bairi Dariyon. Shramik Bharti provided her with a grain storage tank of 500 kg capacity on 5th Feb 2016 along with 450 kg wheat free of cost. There are 12 members in the SHG. The wheat is provided to the needy villagers from the grain bank. A person taking 50 kg of wheat has to return 62.5 kg of wheat i.e. 12.5 kg extra. Currently 6 to 7 families have borrowed wheat, some of them have already returned the grains as stipulated.

Note to the donor: GiveIndia's Relationship Managers travel to the most remote parts of the country to conduct the verification visits. These visits are very important to ensure our donors that we maintain a high level of trust in the ecosystem. A successful verification visit is a strong indicator that this NGO can be trusted with your donations and will utilize the funds raised to provide support to the intended beneficiaries.
